

INVITATION TO BID

Johnson County Business 13 Highway Rehabilitation

Sealed bids for Johnson County Business 13 Highway Rehabilitation, will be received at: 300 N. Holden Street, Suite 201, Warrensburg, MO 64093 until 1:00 p.m. on the 20th day of February, 2025, at the office of the Johnson County Commission, and at 1:30 p.m. on the 20th day of February, 2025, bids will be publicly opened and read at the office of the Johnson County Commission, Suite 203. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a hard copy.

The proposed work includes:

The rehabilitation of approximately 5 miles of pavement along Co. Rd. Business 13 in Johnson County, MO including 2" milling and asphalt overlay and approximately 2,000 SY of full depth pavement repair. All associated pavement marking is also included.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (State Wage Rates).

The Johnson County Commission hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, current Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder complying with the Conditions of the Contract Documents within the Owner's budget. The Bidder to whom the awards are made will be notified at the earliest possible date. The Owner, however, reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any informality in Bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in his interest.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
