CANDIDATE FILING INFORMATION AUGUST 6, 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION

When and Where to File: Filing opens on February 27, 2024 at 8:00 a.m. and closes on March 26, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. The filing process must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on March 26, 2024 and any filing not completed by that time will not be accepted. (RSMo. 115.349) Johnson County, Missouri Candidate Filing is held in the Johnson County Courthouse, County Clerk Office located in Suite 201, at 300 North Holden Street in Warrensburg, Missouri.

Independent candidates will not file for the Primary Election but will have until 5:00 p.m. on July 29, 2024, to file a nomination petition with the County Clerk in order to be placed on the November 5, 2024 General Election ballot.

Ballot Placement: Candidates who file on the first day by 4:30 p.m. will select a number by random drawing. The random number drawn determines the candidate's primary ballot placement. After the first day, candidates are placed on the ballot in the order of their filing. (RSMo. 115.395) Candidates will be placed on the ballot as explained previously except that in the general election, the Republican candidate will be first on the ballot as Missouri has a Republican Governor in office.

- 3. **Affidavit of Tax Payments** (Form 5120) (RSMo. 115.342 & 115.306) notarized. Must be presented at time of filing. (document and Notary available at Clerk's office)
- 4. **Treasurer (RSMo. 54.070) and Public Administrator Candidates (RSMo. 473.730)** Signed Bonding Affidavit from bonding agent stating candidate will meet the office's bonding requirements if they are elected.
