I, _____ (applicant printed name) am an authorized representative for the aforementioned applicant and have read the Ordinance and Order of the Johnson County Commission Regulating Construction and Use of County Maintained Public Road Right of Way dated December 9, 2024 and agree to be bound to the requirements set forth in the Ordinance and Order of the Johnson County Commission Regulating Construction and Use of County-Maintained Public Road Right of Way dated December 9, 2024. If work started before application is approved and fee and bond is paid, fees or restoration may be required. I understand that I am responsible for all damages and needed restoration to county roads and right of way, reimbursement of damage shall be made in full if adequate repairs are not made. I also understand the County may stop the project until damage is repaired.

Revocations. The County may, after reasonable notice and an opportunity to cure, revoke a right-of-way permit granted to a right-of-way user, with or without fee refund, and/or impose a penalty as established by the County until the breach is cured, but only in the event of a substantial breach of the terms and material conditions of the permit. A substantial breach by a permittee includes, but is not limited to: (1) a material violation of a provision of the right-of-way permit; (2) an evasion or attempt to evade any material provision of the right-of-way permit, or the perpetration or attempt to perpetrate any fraud or deceit upon the County or its citizens; (3) a material misrepresentation of fact in the right-of-way permit application; (4) a failure to complete work by the date specified in the right-of-way permit, unless a permit extension is obtained or unless the failure to complete the work is due to reasons beyond the permittee's control; and (5) a failure to correct, within the time specified by the political subdivision, work that does not conform to applicable national safety codes, industry construction standards, or local safety codes that are no more stringent than national safety codes, upon inspection and notification by the County of the faulty condition.

Enforcement. As a condition of submitting an application under Ordinance 24-03 Amended December 9, 2024 and receiving a permit or other approval under this Order, the applicant acknowledges and agrees that the applicant shall be liable in an action brought in the name of the County for the enforcement of the provisions of this Order. In addition to any other remedies County may have at law or in equity, an applicant shall be responsible for all of the County's costs, charges and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred in connection with the interpretation, application and enforcement of the provisions of this Order or due to a breach of the terms and conditions of issuance of a permit, including, but not limited to failure to post a sufficient or appropriate surety bond, to obtain and maintenance required insurance, failure to submit required deposits and fees; failure to comply with required specifications and setbacks; failure to restore damage to the right-of-way.
