### **Duties of the Circuit Court**

- Civil lawsuits over \$25,000.
- Court record retention.
- · Filing of wills and administrative of assets.
- Estates including decedents, minors, incapacitated and • disabled persons.
- Ex Parte Order of Protection. This differs from the Restraining Order, which is issued by an attorney.
- Felonies, misdemeanors and civil cases up to \$30,000.

- Files Mechanic's Liens.
- Jury selection and jury duty.
- Marriage Dissolutions; however, those interested in dissolutions are urged to seek legal advice through an attorney. No forms are available in this office.
- Municipal tickets for Holden, Leeton, Chilhowee, Centerview, and Kingsville.
- Name change, juvenile, felony and adoption cases.
- Small claims, garnishments, sequestrations and appeals.
- Traffic tickets issued by the Missouri Highway Patrol, Johnson County Sheriff's Dept. and Conservation Agents.
