July 6, 2022 is last day to register for August 2, 2022 Primary Election

WARRENSBURG, MO -- Johnson County Clerk, Diane Thompson reminds county residents of the 5:00 p.m. deadline on Wednesday, July 6th to register to vote for the August 2, 2022, Primary Election. If residents have moved from another Missouri County or have moved from another state, the resident will need to register with Johnson County prior to the deadline. Voters moving from one county to another within Missouri are considered a “new registrant”, not an address change.

In-Person Voter Registration Location:

Warrensburg – Johnson County Courthouse, Voter Registration Office

Mail-In Voter Applications Locations:

Mail-in registration cards must be post marked as of Wednesday, July 6th to be valid for the August 2, 2022, Primary Election. Mail in cards may be used for initial registration, transfer, change of address and name changes.

Voters may also register online at www.sos.mo.gov. Online voter registrations must be completed by the 5 PM deadline on July 6th to be eligible for the August 2, 2022, Primary Election.
