


Johnson County Spirit Trail

Public Hearing for Recreation Trail Program Grant Funds to assist with additional paving of the Spirit Trail at 300 N. Holden, Warrensburg, Missouri

The County is interested in obtaining all citizens' input on recreational needs within the County. As part of the hearing process citizens will be asked to give public comment. The comments will detail what the residents feel are the recreational needs of the community. The County needs as much local participation as possible in order to reflect the true desires of the community as a whole, as well as the comments relating to the proposed project application. The State Department of Natural Resources has established a maximum Fiscal Year Recreational Trail Program (RTP) application request of \$250,000. No displacement of persons will be proposed by this project.

The County is proposing to apply for additional paving of the Spirit Trail currently under construction, for hiking and bicycling use. The grant application will request up to \$170,000 with a county match of approximately \$46,000. All citizens are encouraged to attend in order to comment on the proposed activities.
