**BID SPECIFICATIONS**

The Johnson County Commission is requesting proposals for culvert pipe for use by the Johnson County Road and Bridge Department.

- No stacking of 15” to 24” pipes
- The spiral aluminized type 2 corrugated metal pipe shall consist of metals and coating with 3” x 1”, or 5” x 1” corrugation as required
- The pipe shall conform to the requirements of AASHTO M274, AASHTO M36
- The pipe shall meet MoDOT specifications




**COORDINATION** The Johnson County Road and Bridge Department will closely coordinate this work with the expected schedule of the contractor.
