

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Separate sealed bids for the construction of the **The Villages of Whiteman Street Improvements, Knob Noster, Missouri.**

The project consists of approximately 6700 linear feet of street improvements. Base Bid includes FDR, cement incorporation, grading, rolling, sealing, curing and overlay. An alternate project approach will be bid and include removals, asphalt overlay, milling, wedging, subgrade repairs, and all necessary appurtenances and incidentals including areas of complete street removal and replacement. The two project approaches are to be separately bid with one bidder to be awarded the contract. The County reserves the right to analyze the bids received and select the bid that best fits in the allotted budget and award contract on that basis.

Bids will be received by Johnson County, Warrensburg Missouri at the office of the County Clerk at Johnson County Courthouse until 1:30 p.m., March 5th, 2020, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Any and all bids received after the time and date specified above will be returned unopened.

Johnson County reserves the right to award the contract to the “lowest and best responsible bidder”. The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids. The County further reserves the right to waive any irregularities in any or all bids and reserves the right to determine which is the most responsive, responsible bidder and to reject or approve the bids. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security of 5% of the total amount of the bid (bid bond, cashier’s check, or approved money order payable to the Johnson County, Missouri). Work under this contract to be fully complete by October 15, 2020. The wage rates applicable for this project has been predetermined as required by the State of Missouri Prevailing Wage Law and are set forth in the proposal. The Contractor shall comply with all requirements with regard to immigration and e-verification of citizenship. The Contractor shall also comply with all requirements with regard to OSHA safety training and requirements. Only Missouri laborers and laborers from nonrestrictive states are allowed by law to be employed on Missouri’s public works projects when the unemployment rate exceeds 5% for two consecutive months. Bonding and insurance requirements are set forth in the proposal.
